### **Is This Hadeeth Authentic?**

**Q:** The Prophet (*Sallallahu alaihi wa sallam*) said whoever says,

حسبي الله لا إله إلا هو عليه توكلت وهو رب العرش العظيم

“Allah is sufficient for me, nothing has the right to be worshipped in truth except Him, I put my trust in Him the Lord of the mighty throne, seven times in the morning and evening; Allah will suffice him in that which is important to him from the affairs of this world and the hereafter.”

Is this Hadeeth authentic?

**A:** This Hadeeth has come with a chain that stops at Abu Ad Dardaa (*radi Allahu ‘anhu*) from the narrations collected by Abu Dawud with a good chain with the wording,

Whoever says,

حسبي الله لا إله إلا هو عليه توكلت وهو رب العرش العظيم

**Allah is sufficient for me, nothing has the right to be worshipped in truth except Him, I put my trust in Him the Lord of the mighty throne, seven times in the morning and evening; Allah will suffice him in that which is important to him.**

Without the mentioned addition,

“...from the affairs of this world and the hereafter.”

The Hadeeth has come with a chain that stops at Abu Ad Dardaa (*radi Allahu 'anhu*) and does not reach back to the Prophet (*SallAllahu alaihi wa sallam*). However, it takes the ruling of a Hadeeth that reaches back to the Prophet (*SallAllahu alaihi wa sallam*) because affairs like this are not spoken about from the standpoint of opinion, and with Allah is all success.
